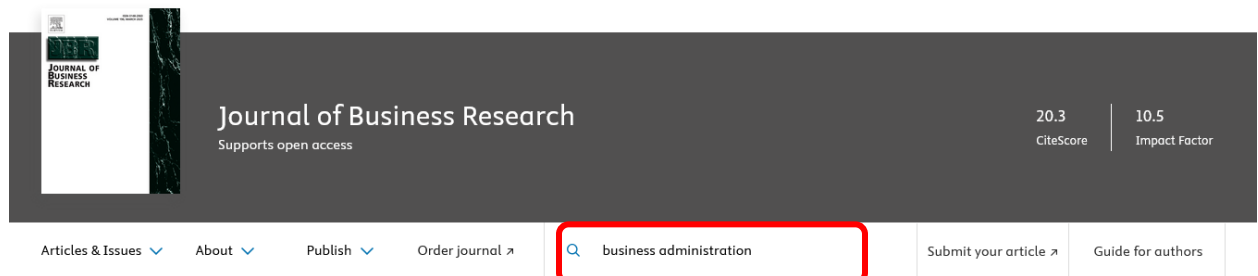

We further theorize that these entrepreneurs are more likely to exit the business voluntarily rather than involuntarily, using business exit as a coping mechanism to proactively manage risks before the actual losses occur. An empirical analysis of data from the 2017 Survey of Business Owners (SBO 2017) provided by the United States Census Bureau supports our hypotheses. This study contributes to our knowledge of how military service affects entrepreneurs' decisions regarding business exit.'
